Course Description:

This course is the first of two parts (the second being ADA4M) that are based upon theatre history. ADA3M encompasses many important theatrical movements from Greek Theatre to Moliere. An in-depth academic analysis of the movements, as well as a representative script from each movement are the foundations of the performance tasks for the course.

Unit 1: Review: The Elements of Drama and Dramatic Forms

Unit 2: Theatre Production: Lights, Set and Sound (Scene Study)

Unit 3: Theatre History: Greek Tragedy (Group Scene Study: *Oedipus the King*)

Unit 4: History and Theories of Acting (Solo Duologue)

Unit 5: Shakespearean Tragedy (Research Project)

Unit 6: Stage Combat (Fight Routine)

Unit 7: Summative 1: One Act Play

Summative 2: Reflective Journal

Assessment and Evaluation:
