



Scoring Games on Fatdog:

This year the Athletics Association has decided to try a more centralized approach for updating league results on the Fatdog Website.

Each school AD has (or will create) a login and password for updating scores on Fatdog. The AD's will share their login name and password with their coaches for all to be able to update scores as needed.

For several schools ADs have already been proactive in the game scoring process, requesting that they always be the second scorer for any of the leagues their school participates in. They do not need to change their login information, they just need to share it.

For some schools, the AD will need to create a fatdog "account" . This is a very simple procedure, much like creating accounts on any website, which almost all are familiar with doing.

This involves going to www.fatdog.ca and following the steps to register, filling in the required fields. A password is generated by the fatdog server and sent by email to the person registering. The ADs email address is the login name.

ADs can rest assured that this fatdog login and password is **not** connected in **any** way to their day-to-day operations within their schools, and coaches will not be able to access AD emails. The purpose of the email address is to have a point of contact if someone forgot the password, in which case it would be emailed to the address provided on registration (the ADs)
