Earl of March Athlete Expectations

A student chosen to represent our school in interscholastic activities is granted a privilege and an honour, with the understanding that this comes with a set of responsibilities. Students representing Earl of March Secondary School in athletics must maintain an acceptable standing in the school as reflected by their good academic performance and good behaviour based on our school's Code of Behaviour.

In addition, in order to play on any school athletic team and to maintain their status on school teams, an EoM Student/Athlete must adhere to the following Athletic Policy:

1. Each student/athlete must work to achieve academic success.
2. School attendance is compulsory. Student/athletes absent from school for the entire day are ineligible to take part in practices or competitions and must inform their coach at the earliest possible moment.
3. If a student/athlete is absent for part of a day, the student/athlete is required to follow the EoM School handbook for proper procedures. (ie signing in and out) If proof of these procedures is not met, the student will not be permitted to participate in any games or practices that day.
4. Student/Athletes must adhere to the school Code of Behaviour as outlined in the student handbook.
5. All student/athletes must comply with the financial obligations determined by the circumstances of the team. If unable to do so please notify the teacher/coach.
6. Lion student/athletes are expected to demonstrate true sportsmanship, recognizing and applauding the efforts of teammates, opponents and officials. True sportsmanship honours effort. It requires modesty in victory and graciousness in defeat.
7. Respect for coaches, fellow players, opponents and officials is expected of all Lion student/athletes. Foul or abusive language or behaviours will not be tolerated, and school sanctions will apply.
8. Commitment is a responsibility of every EoM student/athlete. In being a member of a **LION** team an individual:
 1. Commits to a coach and team for the entire season
 2. Plays only on one "major" team during a particular season
 3. Attends all games, practices and tournaments
9. Earl of March student/athletes must comply fully with the NCSSAA and OFSAA rules of eligibility in order to participate on school teams.
