# What do I do?

### 1- Complete 4 Senior Business credits and 2 Coop credits

You need a *bundle of credits* in grades **11 and 12**, as follows:

A total of 4 of these Major Subject credits, with a minimum of 1 Grade 11 & 1 Grade 12 credit and 2 Coop credits linked to a major subject credit
