French, Grade 12, University :

This course provides for extensive study of French literature and culture from the Middle Ages to the present. Students will study novels, plays, poems, films and nonfiction works produced in various historical periods, and will write a formal research paper. The use of correct grammar and appropriate language conventions in both spoken and written French will be emphasized throughout the course.

What you will be learning:

Oral Communication

- understand the content and interpret the message conveyed by a variety of media works;
- speak with native-like fluency on a variety of topics ranging from personal life to global issues;
- express and explain abstract ideas;
- use correct grammar and appropriate language conventions during oral communication activities

Reading

- read a range of literary and other works to deepen their appreciation of francophone culture around the world;
- research a range of source materials to clarify their ideas and verify their points of view;
- analyse and interpret complete works or excerpts from works in a variety of genres;
- identify and understand language conventions used in their reading materials

Writing

- write clearly, logically, coherently, and persuasively on a broad range of topics in a variety of forms;
- express and explain abstract ideas in their writing;
- write essays and research papers on a variety of topics;
- use correct grammar and appropriate language conventions in their written work.

How you will demonstrate your learning and be evaluated: The course will be evaluated as follows for each term: The total course work based on overall expectations will be worth 70% and the remaining 30% from the Summative evaluation(s). A variety of assessment tools will be used to assess students' work and performance including a personalized summative project and other assignments for evaluation. There will be added emphasis on communication in French for students enrolled in the immersion section.
